
Charles Crumpler, M.D. is such a man. He has served as chairman of the Board of Directors for Perkins Partnership Ministries (PPM) since its beginning in June,

2008. His wise counsel and patient guidance, surrounded by a brilliant board, has kept us on track.


Dr. Crumpler is a man of highest morals, impeccable character, brilliant mind, tireless worth ethic, unwavering faith, true friend, and loving husband and father.

Recipe from Peggy

Wafer Cake

Ingredients:

- 6 whole eggs
- 1 cup coconut (not frozen)
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1 box vanilla wafers
- 2 C sugar

1 C chopped nuts (we use pecans)

Instructions:

Beat eggs well. Crush vanilla wafers. Mix wafers and all other ingredients into eggs. Pour into greased (spray works good) and floured tube pan. (Bundt pan works great)

Bake at 350 for one hour or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Right from the oven, turn pan upside down onto wax paper - cake should fall right out.
