## Perkins Partnership Ministries Mission Night at Hwy. 80 Feb. 25





**PPM Travels to Israel**

On a recent cool, crisp and incredibly bright and clear morning, I stood on The Mount of Olives and gazed across the Kidron Valley to the shining Holy City on the hill, Jerusalem. I had dreamed of this moment for a long time. As I took in this sight, it seemed as if I was actually looking back into the centuries past. I could see the narrow streets where Jesus had walked. I saw many sights which He assuredly saw. I saw olive trees which were alive when He was alive, and which actually may have heard Him praying and teaching. I listened carefully as the guide recounted a story about Neil Armstrong, the moon-walking astronaut, on a journey to this same city. He is purported to say that his steps on the moon were not nearly so exciting to him as "walking in the same steps as my Savior walked." Over the next several days, I was honored to walk (or run--the schedule was very

tight!) over the same land where Jesus walked some 2000 years ago. The Sea of Galilee, Capernaum, the site of the Sermon on the Mount, all these places which had seen the feet of Jesus were mine to enjoy.

One such place in which I walked was past a skull-shaped hill and down to a Garden Tomb. As far as the world is concerned, this was where the steps of Jesus ended. To those of us to whom the Truth has been imparted by The Blood shed on these very lands, it is clear that this was not the end, but only the beginning. Those footsteps have continued to lead down through history to the present day. What is crucial for us today is to search carefully so that we may understand exactly where the footsteps lead us.

It is my sure and certain belief that those footsteps are clearly walking

through East Texas today. I know that they led through Atlanta, Texas for the recent Tall Pines festival. The sound of those footsteps continues to reverberate through that city even today. On a recent visit to that city, I heard many comments indicating how much that event influenced (and continues to influence) their lives.
