 Only One?
 (Musings on lessons
 from Tall Pines)

Sometimes I find myself contemplating questions with no “knowable” answer. For instance—have you ever wondered why God chooses to spread His Good News through such imperfect messengers as humans? Surely a God of limitless power could have picked from a myriad of more efficient ways of proclaiming the Gospel instead of depending on us. But He didn't—He chose you and me. I could speculate endlessly on for the possible reasons for this (and when I get to Heaven, I'll find out), but what is important is to realize we **ARE** that choice. It is crucial that we recognize both the blessings and responsibilities which go with being that choice. And while watching events unfold at the Tall Pines Festival, God impressed on my heart some of both the blessings and responsibilities.

As an example, I saw and heard Mike Silva preach a God-inspired message and saw evidence of many decisions in response to that message. I then saw and heard Siran Stacy give a similarly inspired and uniquely individual message to the remaining crowd, and saw another group of people respond. I couldn't help but wonder “What if Siran hadn't been here to speak tonight? What would have been the fate of those people who just responded?”

Also, I heard Dan, one of the Riders 4 Christ, discuss how he wanted to ride bikes with Kyle Loza, and that opportunity allowed Kyle to lead Dan to The Lord. And I thought, “Could either Mike or Siran have been as likely to inspire Dan to open his heart to the Holy Spirit as Kyle? And what would have happened to Dan if Kyle hadn't been faithful in his witness? And what of those who have been moved by Dan's testimony since?” And what about those whose hearts were moved by Stephen Baldwin, Jez, Flame and the other speakers? Which individual was moved by a judge's prayer or a multicultural choir's loving rendition of the National Anthem? Obviously no one knows the answer to these questions other than God. But what I do know is that for all those who yielded to the Lordship of Jesus Christ that night, there was at least one special person who influenced them to open their heart to the Holy Spirit's urging. All of these occurrences were part of God's unique plan for bringing those souls to Him.

I remember recently hearing the testimony of a dedicated soul winner. Prior to becoming a Christian, he had been deeply involved in many of the most horrible sins imaginable. He freely admitted that in his former life, anyone who spoke to him about Jesus would be ridiculed and reviled. But he also said that he remembered the name and face of every one who spoke the Truth to him as well as every word spoken to him. He now reveres these people as having pointed his way to the Savior.
