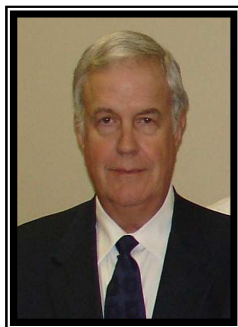
A Word from the President

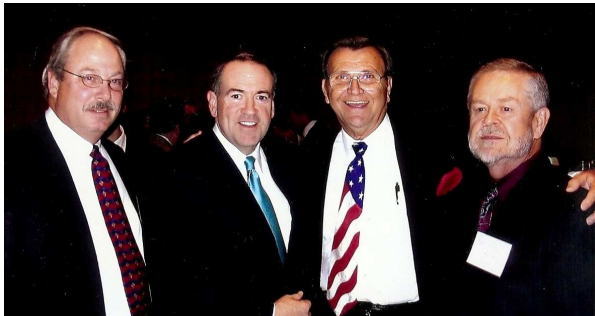

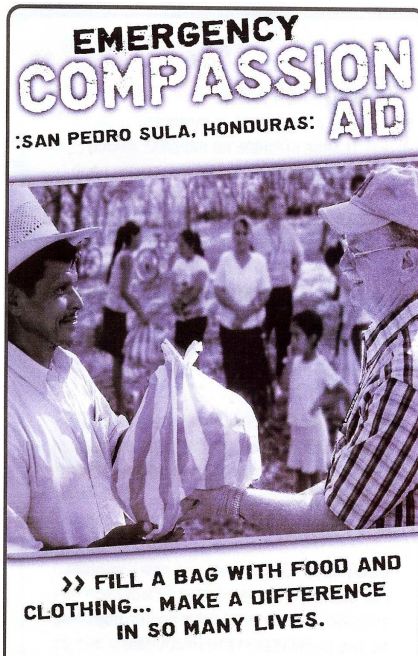

Between now and January 20, 2009, bring your bagged items to the Perkins Partnership Ministries office at 1125 Judson Plaza, Ste. 182. Listed below are the instructions given to us for the items:**

HOW TO PACK A BAG

1. Use a 14-gallon kitchen bag –plastic
2. Separate bags for clothing / food

FOOD IDEAS: Include items that are non-perishable e.g. rice, beans, pasta, powdered milk, cereal, canned fruit/vegetables

CLOTHING IDEAS: Include new clothing for babies, children, adults. Summer clothing is a good choice due to the warm climate in Honduras. (Please do not include used or damaged clothing; clothing that has any military, camouflage or inappropriate artwork).
