










I came to know the Lord as my savior in 2023 when I was looking at a two and a half year prison sentence. The Lord freed me from that. I began to seek him and learn what it was to hear his voice, and began to rejoice in the freedom and the forgiveness that he had given me,. but, there was one thing that I complained about even though I knew God said I was beautiful no matter what. Every time I looked in the mirror and saw my rotted, broken teeth it damaged my spirit without me even knowing it. I started doing my recovery out loud so that others would know that there was a different life, but the more I looked at those videos and saw what I thought other people seen, I began to get discouraged; not to mention the pain I felt physically, and as I sought the Lord and put my face toward him first, I stopped the complaining. I still saw the wreckage in the mirror, I was provided the opportunity to have all my teeth removed, I couldn't believe that the Lord's grace and mercy was falling upon me so abundantly. I came to the end of self. From that moment, I began to understand how faithful the Lord is to his promises.

The one thing that I learned throughout all of this-God is so good once we let him have control. When we show our gratefulness and our thankfulness, and stop chasing after our own way and desires we put everythingfully in his hands and release and surrender fully to His willHe will do things beyond what we could ask. I may not have any teeth at this moment but I am so blessed and favored in the Lord's promises. I am living proof that when you come to the end and trust in the Father that he will do the things you dreamed of. And that our prayers, even in silence, He is so faithful to answer in His timing
